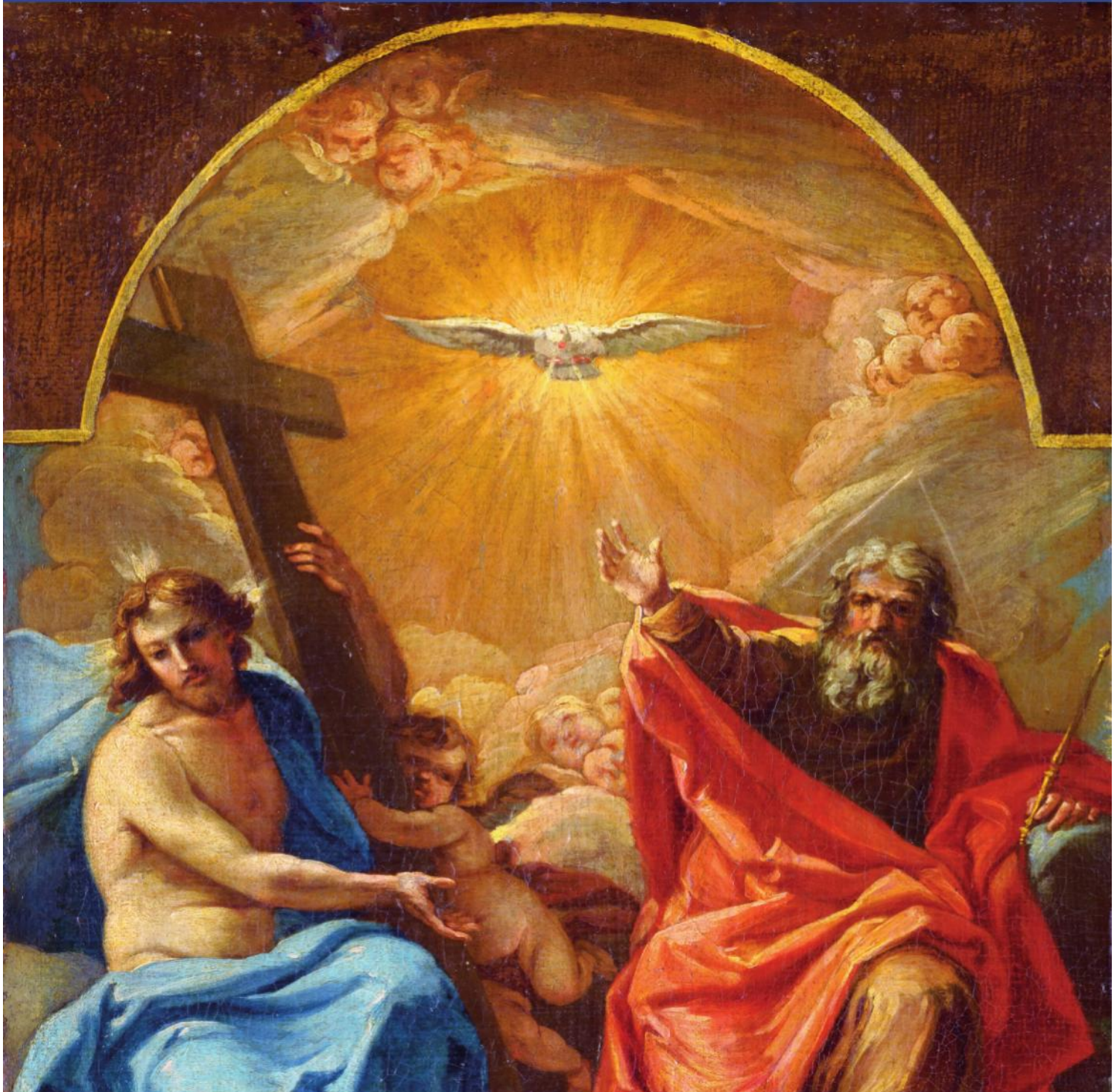

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings on this, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity! As Christians, we believe in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. These three divine persons are a single communion of infinite, eternal love. Let us ponder deeply this central mystery of our faith and give thanks to God for his trinitarian presence in our Church.

Our country celebrates Memorial Day this weekend, the unofficial start of the summer. As Catholics, we pray for the men and women who have given their lives in service to their country. May God grant them eternal rest, and may their sacrifices be dutifully honored by a grateful nation.

Please remember to keep up your holy habits throughout the summer: Mass, prayer, service, reading Scripture, confession, etc. While we take time to relax during these hot summer months, let us not become lukewarm in the practice of our Catholic faith. ## THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

### FIRST READING

**Dt 4: 32-34, 39-40**

Moses said to the people: "Ask now of the days of old, before your time, ever since God created man upon the earth; ask from one end of the sky to the other: Did anything so great ever happen before? Was it ever heard of? Did a people ever hear the voice of God speaking from the midst of fre, as you did, and live?

Or did any god venture to go and take a nation for himself from the midst of another nation, by testings, by signs and wonders, by war, with strong hand and outstretched arm, and by great terrors, all of

which the LORD, your God, did for you in Egypt before your very eyes?

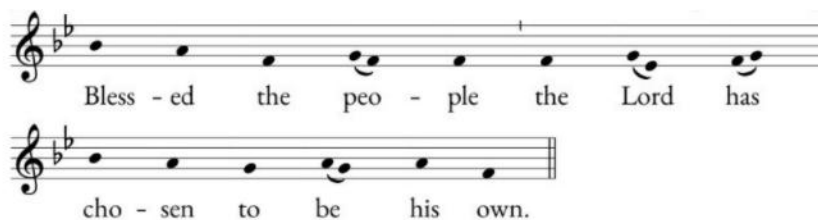
This is why you must now know, and fix in your heart, that the LORD is God in the heavens above and on earth below, and that there is no other.
