FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



In this weekend's Gospel, we see the tenderness of Jesus' heart. He is moved with compassion when He sees the vast crowd – they are like sheep without a shepherd. Jesus was sent by the Father to shepherd God's People. Psalm 23 reminds us that He is the Good Shepherd who remains at our side to give us courage, comfort, and strength.

This reflection is fitting as we wish farewell to Michael Rhatican, a parishioner of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc. Several years ago, Michael heard Jesus' words: "As the Father sends me, so I send you." He responded in faith and entered the seminary to study to be a priest. Later this week, he will travel to Rome to continue his studies in preparation for his priesthood

ordination that will take place in 2028. Let us pray for Michael, that he be formed into an excellent shepherd for the Church.

Let us also pray for everyone participating in *Totus Tuus* at our parish this week. *Totus Tuus* is Latin for *Totally Yours*. It is an experience of faith for young Catholics that is comparable to Vacation Bible School. Activities are led by college-aged adults who have dedicated their summer to sharing the Good News with children. *Totus Tuus* is a beautiful program that helps young people give themselves completely to God in faith.

Lastly, let us pray for Father Elias Udeh and Father Victor Mendez. These two priests generously serve the people of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc. They will be away from the parish for a few weeks on vacation (something not uncommon for international priests whose ministry takes them far from their families). We ask the Good Shepherd to accompany them on their journey and to bring them home safely again. If you see visiting priests covering for Father Elias or Father Victor in the days ahead, please welcome them warmly.
