I am happy to announce that Sister Monika Maria will be joining our staff. Originally from Germany, Sister Monika taught at Ready High School on the west side of Columbus School last year. Now, she will support our Family Catechesis program, focusing on the education of our youngest children. We are blessed to have a religious sister working in our parish! Her presence is a reminder (especially to the girls and young women) that the religious life is a beautiful vocation in the life of the Church.

Sister Monika is not the only missionary we are meeting. All the parishes in the Diocese of Columbus take part in a Missionary Appeal each year. To that end, Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc Parish welcomes two missionaries to our community, though they will be with us only for a few






