## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



There is a lot of excitement in our parish because of the Community Festival taking place this week. Please pray for a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone. There are many reasons to host a summer festival, including evangelization. Our church is going to connect with the broader community in a significant way; people will be stepping foot on our campus for the first time. Our goal is to show them a vibrant parish that is worthy of their consideration. Perhaps the Holy Spirit will inspire some visitors to learn more about the Catholic faith and to seek God in the Church. My hope is that the Community Festival leads many souls to discover the goodness of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc, as well as the beauty of Christ who is at work in our parish.

A wonderful addition to our parish is Deacon Fidel Pitones. Deacon Fidel was ordained a transitional deacon last Saturday, which was the Feast of Saint Lawrence. This was the perfect feast day for a diaconate ordination! Saint Lawrence was a venerable deacon in Ancient Rome who tended to the poor and whose witness of heroic faith brought about massive conversions to Christianity. He ultimately died a martyr's death when the pagan Emperor, Valerian, commanded that Saint Lawrence be burned alive on a griddle. We will treat our parish's new deacon with a little more respect! Even if he is not called to be a martyr, I expect Deacon Fidel to imitate Saint Lawrence's desire to share the Good News in both word and deed. If you see Deacon Fidel in the days ahead, please congratulate him on his recent ordination. Let us welcome him warmly to our community.

Everything is donated. The lead gardener even adds her homegrown excess to the donations. The harvest is delivered to homeless people in downtown Columbus and the remaining produce goes to Help My Neighbor. We are in our 9th season and add more beds, planters and trellises each year. #### SANDWICH MINISTRY

## Did you know that each month, St. Teresa's Outreach is committed to collecting over 1,000 bologna sandwiches to serve the homeless in downtown Columbus?

We need volunteers to help bring this important ministry to St. Peter campus in September!

#### What is our Sandwich Ministry?

Parishioners make bags of bologna and cheese sandwiches at home and drop off the sandwiches before Mass one weekend per month. Volunteers then deliver crates of sandwiches to St. Joseph Cathedral in downtown Columbus for distribution to the homeless.

The next parish-wide sandwich collection will take place before all Masses on September 7-8.

At Saint Peter campus, we need collection volunteers to collect bags of sandwiches in the Gathering Space before each Mass and store those bags in the refrigerator/freezer and to ensure no bags of sandwiches have been left out after Mass.

We need delivery volunteer(s) to pick up the bags of sandwiches from Saint Peter and deliver them to Saint Joseph Cathedral on the second Tuesday morning of the month.
