The Role of the Church in American Political Life

Our national tradition of religious freedom encourages all people of faith to express their religious convictions in the public square. During his visit to the U.S., Pope Francis affirmed that religious liberty transcends places of worship, individuals, and families and is integral to the culture of every nation.



In his most recent encyclical, Pope Francis wrote, "If society is to have a future, it must respect the truth of our human dignity and submit to that truth" (*Fratelli Tutti*, no. 207). The sanctity of human life, the equal dignity of all individuals, the obligation to protect the vulnerable, and the nature and purposes of sex, marriage, and family are not exclusively "religious" truths but truths that can be known by natural reason.

As Catholics, we must illuminate these truths to our nation through our unique roles in the Church's mission:

Bishops/Clergy: govern the Church, uphold doctrine, and administer sacraments.

<u>In political life:</u> clergy help form the laity with basic principles, but do not tell the laity to vote for particular candidates.

Lay Faithful: bring the gospel to the world, advocate for justice, and serve in public office.

<u>In political life:</u> the laity are called to form their consciences and make informed decisions to fulfill their duty to vote and participate in public life.

It is our responsibility to study Catholic teaching and tradition, participate in the Church's life, learn from trustworthy sources about the issues facing our communities, and do our best to make wise judgments about candidates and public policy. By forming our consciences for faithful citizenship, we can better pursue the common good and obey the command of our Lord to love our neighbors.

WE WILL BE OPENING UP OUR MASS INTENTION BOOK FOR 2025 ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3.

What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone? A priest offers every Mass for a particular intention. The most common intention is for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. A parishioner may ask a priest to offer a Mass for his or her deceased loved ones or for other special intentions.

You can stop by the Parish Office at Saint Joan of Arc to schedule an intention for Masses celebrated at both campuses in 2025.

A Mass Intention will only be scheduled when the person presents the priest's stipend amount of \$10.00. The stipend amount is fixed and should be no more, no less than \$10.00.

An individual or family may schedule:

- A maximum of 10 Masses in one calendar year.
- A limit of 2 weekend Masses (as part of the 10 limit)
- An intention for the same person 4 weeks apart if weekday Mass or 4 months apart if a weekend Mass.
