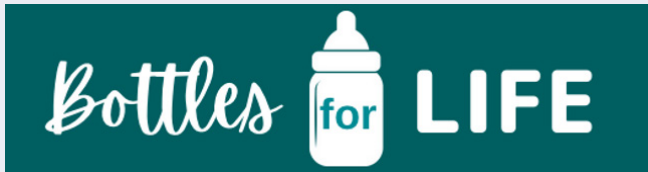

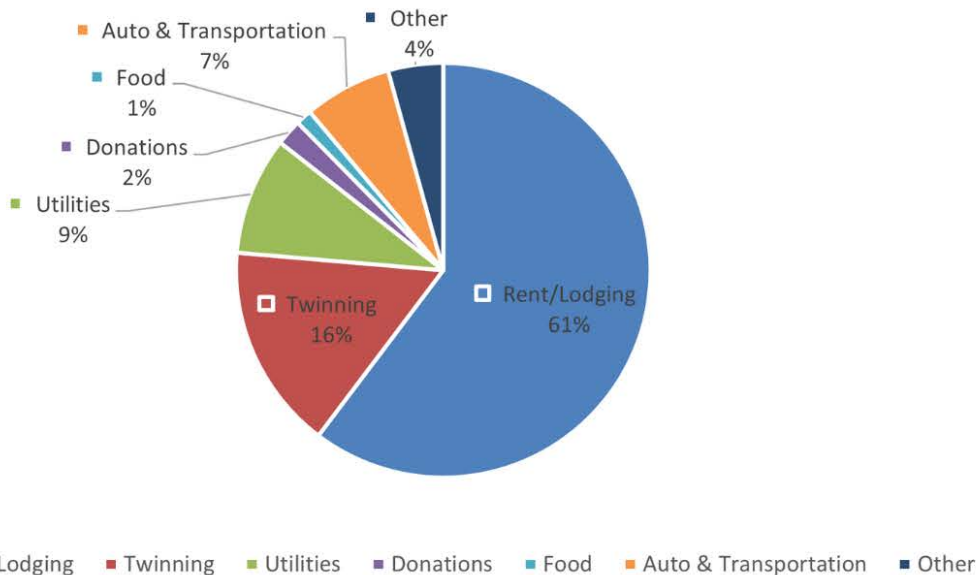

The Saint Peter conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society thanks the members of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc for their generosity. As you know we provide short-term relief, usually financial, to people in need and we try to concentrate on the general area of our parish boundaries and contiguous zip codes. Sometimes we twin with other councils around the city to help individuals outside of our parish boundaries. In this fiscal year we assisted 225 individuals for a total distribution of \$55,349 to our neighbors in need, \$700 in Kroger cards for food, and other help directing individuals to alternative sources (e.g., food pantries and lodging). Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc parishioners have been most generous, and we thank you for thinking of those in need. Please continue including us in your online giving and collections after Mass for the poor, as we will have increasing need during the upcoming holidays. 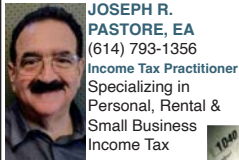

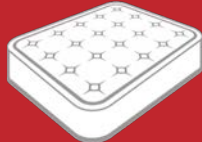
