Let me begin by expressing my gratitude. Thank you to our parishioners who participated in the Fall Food Drive. Your generosity makes a difference in the lives of our brothers and sisters in need. Thank you also to everyone who has turned in a Stewardship of Time Commitment Form. If you have not done so yet, there is still time! Please continue to discern how you can offer your time to God through prayer, service, or ministry in the church. And thank you to all those who were involved in the Multicultural Festival last weekend. The event brought much joy and a greater sense of unity to Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc Parish.

This weekend, I am traveling to La Crosse, Wisconsin, for a special gathering of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem. ### PRAYER FOR RESPECT LIFE SUNDAY

Jesus, You came that we might have life – and have it in abundance. Together with the Father and the Holy Spirit, You form us in our mothers' wombs and call us to love You for all eternity. As Your most precious gift of human life is attacked, draw us ever closer to Your Real Presence in the Eucharist. Dispel the darkness of the culture of death, for You are the light that shines in the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it. By the power of Your Eucharistic Presence, help us to defend the life of every human person at every stage. Transform our hearts to protect and cherish all whose lives are most vulnerable. For You are God, forever and ever. Amen.



### Faithful Citizenship: Subsidiarity

In Forming Consciences for Faithful Citizenship, the Catholic bishops of the U.S. identify the four main principles of the Church's social teaching—Dignity of the Human Person, the Common Good, Solidarity, and Subsidiarity—and apply them to concrete issues. This entry focuses on Subsidiarity.



Subsidiarity is a principle that larger institutions (such as the state or federal government) should not overwhelm or interfere with smaller or local institutions (such as the family, local schools, or the Church community). And, when local entities cannot uphold human dignity, meet human needs, or advance the common good, larger entities have responsibilities to ensure all people can thrive.

Respecting this principle promotes the flourishing of each person and the realization of the common good. By participating in public life locally, each person and civil society can enrich their neighbors, communities, and society through:

- Defending and strengthening marriage between a man and a woman as the most fundamental unit of society and a sanctuary for creating and nurturing children.<sup>2</sup>
- Upholding parents' rights and responsibilities in directing their children's education in accordance with their convictions, with support rather than interference from the state.<sup>3</sup>
- Strengthening family stability with laws and policies to support parents, including childcare, healthcare, housing assistance, and child tax credits.<sup>4</sup>
- Advocating for economic policies that provide jobs with decent working conditions, fair wages, and protect workers' rights to organize and bargain collectively.<sup>5</sup>

As we pursue the principle of Subsidiarity in our public policies, we pray for all families and those in poverty and support their efforts to exercise their rights and responsibilities in society.




### What is 40 Days for Life?


### CARING FOR YOUR FAMILY CAREGIVER


