

UPDATE FROM SPSJOA

Beginning on Sunday, December 1, the First Week of Advent, we will begin distributing the Precious Blood during Holy Communion. This will take place only during the 10:00 a.m. Mass at Saint Joan of Arc and the 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Masses at Saint Peter. We know that we receive the fullness of Christ – His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity – when we receive the Eucharist under either species of bread or wine. Taking Communion under both species is not required to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace. However, receiving the Eucharist under both species of bread and wine is a more complete sign of the Eucharistic meal. We are happy to introduce this practice once again at our parish.
