

PRECIOUS BLOOD AT MASS

Beginning on Sunday, December 1, we will distribute the Precious Blood of Christ during Communion at the 10:00 a.m. Mass at the Saint Joan of Arc campus, as well as the 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. Masses at the Saint Peter campus. Many children who received their First Communion since the pandemic have not received the Eucharist from the chalice. 


