FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



This weekend, we are launching our annual Offertory Campaign for 2025. This is part of our efforts to promote stewardship in our community, focusing on Stewardship of Treasure. It takes intentionality to be excellent stewards of the material benefits we receive from God. 


