



*Two Masses will be held at the same time: One in the church and one in the McEwan Center.


To ensure a smooth experience, we encourage you to arrive early, follow the directions of those directing parking and seating, and come with a spirit of prayer and patience.





Youth Ministry Corner

A MESSAGE FROM THE SPSJOA LEGACY SOCIETY

The SPSJOA Legacy Society hosted "My Last Wishes" Seminar on November 16, and 60 were in attendance including registrants, Legacy Committee, and speakers. Topics focused on end-of-life decisions that need to be made by everyone, and not just our seniors. In your list of New Year's resolutions, the speakers recommended that the following actions be taken:

- 1. Schedule an appointment at a Catholic cemetery.
- 2. Schedule an appointment with a funeral home director.
- 3. Start planning your funeral service and talk to our clergy on what decisions need to be made.
- 4. If you do not have advance directives or a power of attorney, schedule a time to discuss those with your attorney. Be aware of Catholic teachings affecting advanced directives.
- 5. Review all your property and prepare a written schedule of assets (description, ownership, estimated value) and an inventory of your digital assets, and then start or update your estate planning.
- 6. Continue your discipleship journey and discern making a legacy gift to the parish or its endowment in your planning that will ensure the continuance and enhancement of the mission of our parish after you are gone. Legacy gifts are for everyone no gift is too small.






