FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I wish you a very happy Feast of the Epiphany! This important story from the Bible teaches us that Jesus is the Savior of the Jewish People, as well as the Gentiles. He came to reign over every human heart, regardless of race, language, or culture.

Ingredient in the magi's worship was a sacrifice of their material wealth to God. I am thankful for the parishioners of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc Parish who continue to be excellent stewards of their time, treasure, and talent. When we financially support the Church, we exercise our faith and express our gratitude to God.

As we enter the New Year, are you trying to keep a resolution? In this season of your life, consider making small goals to develop your faith. My suggestion would be to do something a little more (e.g., pray before bed or read a spiritual book) and to do something a little less (e.g., gossip at work or scroll on your phone). Ask God where he wants you to make a change in 2025.

One last thing: we are starting a new daily Mass schedule at our Saint Peter campus. Monday through Friday, we will have Mass in English at 5:30 p.m. Because of the renovations in the church, we will have daily Mass in the Adoration chapel for two weeks. Please note that it will seem strange to some because the priest will celebrate the Mass "ad orientum", that is, facing the same direction as the congregation. We will have Mass "ad orientum" because of where the altar is placed in that space.



THIS SUNDAY, JANUARY 5, IS THE FEAST OF THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD, ONE OF THE OLDEST OF ALL CHRISTIAN FEASTS

It commemorates the visit of the Magi to the Christ Child. Marking our doorways or front porch steps with blessed chalk is a centuries-old Epiphany custom and a fun, visible way to dedicate our homes and the New Year to God. The inscription this year is:

"20" and "25" stand for the new year (2025). The plus signs represent the Cross. CMB are the first initials of the traditional names given to the Magi — Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. They also abbreviate the Latin "Christus mansionem benedicat," or "May Christ bless the house."

We will have blessed chalk available after all the Masses this weekend for you to take home.



Did you know that each month, St. Teresa's Outreach is committed to collecting over 1,000 bologna sandwiches to serve the homeless in downtown Columbus?


WE NEED VOLUNTEERS TO CONTINUE THIS IMPORTANT MINISTRY!






