

HOMILY ON THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD – January 5, 2025

Readings: Isaiah 60:1-6, Psalm 72:1-2, 7-8, 10-13, Eph 3:2-3a, 5-6, Mt 2:1-12.

My dear friends in Christ Jesus, today we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC no 528), "The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as the Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Savior of the World,"

In the gospel reading today, the magi, or wise men from the east saw the star of the newborn King of the Jews and followed the star to pay him homage.
