### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Let me thank you again for supporting our parish's efforts to care for the poor. We have a great variety of ministries that assist our brothers and sisters in need. Most of these ministries are under the umbrella of Saint Teresa's Outreach, also known as STO. Funding for STO primarily comes from the special collection after Mass on the last Sunday of each month, as well as from donations made on our website. Know that your generosity to STO is greatly appreciated!

In case you have not yet heard, several of our parishioners and I will travel to Belize to volunteer at Sacred Heart Parish and School in June. This international mission trip will provide an opportunity for us to practice the corporal works of mercy. It will also help our parish better understand the needs of the poor in foreign countries. Though we are

a few months away from traveling, I am asking that parishioners pray even now for the mission volunteers and the people in Belize whom we will serve.

Speaking of traveling, Bryan Inderhees is currently on pilgrimage in Rome. Bryan is a parishioner from Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc who has been preparing for his deaconate ordination for several years. ### DEEPEN YOUR FAITH THIS LENT

prayer, fasting, + almogiving

The Church requires all Catholics from ages 14-59 to fast on **Ash Wednesday**and Good Friday. As long as you are in good health, this means that you should only eat one full meal, plus two smaller meals that do not equal a full meal. Catholics also abstain from meat on **Ash Wednesday** and all Fridays during Lent, including Good Friday.



<u>RICE BOWLS</u> Catholic Relief Services' Rice Bowl is a Lenten faith formation program for the entire United States. It helps with fundraising efforts that benefit the poor in countries all around the world. Rice Bowls will be available in the church vestibule for you to take home at the **beginning of Lent**.

LITTLE BLACK BOOKS
There will be copies of The Little Black Book available after all the Masses next weekend. The Little Black Book is a daily devotional to accompany you throughout the Lenten season with prayers and reflections.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross is a powerful and simple way to reflect on the final moments of Jesus' life. **Every Friday in Lent**, we will pray the Stations of the Cross at St. Joan of Arc at 7:00 p.m. in English. Station in Spanish will be at St. Peter at 7:30 p.m.

ALL DAY ADORATION As part of the diocesan 40 Days of Adoration, we will be welcoming guests from all around the diocese to stop by and spend time with the Blessed Sacrament. 
PARISH MISSION
