You will be asked to verify or correct your contact information and Mass preferences. The email will also include more information about how the system works, making it easier for you to manage your schedule and get substitutes when needed.





HELP MY NEIGHBOR GENERAL STATISTICS FROM 2024

Help My Neighbor at Smoky Row Food Pantry provides food to over 300 families in our community each week. A portion of the weekly food collections at St. Joan of Arc and St. Peter campus is sent Help My Neighbor each month. SPSJOA and St. Teresa's Outreach also partner with Help My Neighbor for our Christmas Giving Tree, school supplies collection and our Lenten and fall food drives. The food pantry is open every Wednesday and Saturday of the year, and families are able to shop once a week. No one is turned away, even if they do not qualify for government aid. Local churches, businesses and organizations assist in providing financial and material support to Help My Neighbor.

Our series will last for seven consecutive Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m., beginning on February 27. Registration is required.








