FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Ash Wednesday is this week! The Church throughout the world will, once again, take up the practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving during the holy season of Lent. If you have not done so already, take time to listen to the Holy Spirit; ask God how He is calling you to grow spiritually during these forty days.

My advice for everyone is this: do not take this Lenten journey alone. Share your plans with trusted friends or family members. Ask them to support you in your sacrifices and disciplines. Perhaps you can gently hold them accountable to their Lenten commitments as well.

Typically speaking, non-practicing Catholics (and even non-Christians) are more open to God during Lent. Look for opportunities to invite them to take a leap of faith. Maybe someone in your life would join you at the Stations of the Cross or would appreciate a *Little Black Book* devotional.

Here is my threefold prayer for Lent: 1. For those who are already active members of our community, I ask that God draw them deeper into their Catholic faith. 2. For those who are lukewarm, I ask that God ignite their souls with a renewed love for Him. 3. For those who do not yet know Him, I ask that God show His face and plant in their hearts a desire for a relationship with Jesus.

FASTING DURING LENT

The Church requires all Catholics from ages 14-59 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. As long as you are in good health, this means that you should only eat one full meal, plus two smaller meals that do not equal a full meal. Catholics also abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent, including Good Friday.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross is a powerful and simple way to reflect on the final moments of Jesus' life. Join us this Friday to pray the Stations of the Cross at St. Joan of Arc at 7:00 p.m. in English. Stations in Spanish will be at St. Peter at 7:30 p.m.

RICE BOWLS

Catholic Relief Services' Rice Bowl is a Lenten faith formation program for the entire United States. It helps with fundraising efforts that benefit the poor in countries all around the world. Rice Bowls will be available in the church vestibule for you to take home this weekend.
