We are blessed this weekend with the exquisite parable of the Prodigal Son. It is a story that resonates with each of us. In different ways, we have all run from God, felt the pangs of our conscience, and returned to his arms of mercy. This Lent, let us prayerfully apply this parable to our lives and give thanks for the forgiveness we have in Christ. Let us also lift our grateful hearts to God for the beautiful sacrament of reconciliation. That is the surest road to the loving embrace of the Father.




MONTHLY ALTAR SERVER TRAINING


