## HOMILY FOR FRIDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD (GOOD FRIDAY) – APRIL 18, 2025



Isaiah 52: 13 - 53: 12, Psalm 31: 2,6,12-13, 15-17, 25 Hebrew 4: 14-16; 5: 7-9, John 18: 1-19:42
