


Discipleship Opportunity Reflection

Reflection is a critical part of a service-learning experience. Students who take the time to reflect on their service experiences will get more from those experiences. This is why reflections are a required part of Confirmation preparation. Reflection helps students thoughtfully process their work of service. It helps them critically assess and understand what they are seeing and doing. It allows students to be the hands and feet of Jesus.
