FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In this weekend's Gospel, the disciples implore Jesus, "Increase our faith." I think we can all relate. There are times when trusting God's plan for our lives is difficult. Faith takes prayer, patience, and perseverance. Every now and then, we only have the strength to utter: "I believe, Lord; help my unbelief." And in our struggles, we sometimes just whisper to our Savior, "Jesus, I trust in you." And in moments of spiritual darkness, we cry to the Father, "Increase my faith." God responds generously to those simple prayers.

October is Respect Life Month, a time when Catholics throughout the country promote the dignity of every human life, from conception to natural death. I want to thank the work of our parish's Respect Life Committee. They dedicate much time and energy organizing the annual Baby Bottle Drive and our participation in 40 Days for Life. The inspiration of all our Pro-Life efforts is Jesus' Resurrection. Christ overcame death on the third day, and now He calls us to build a Culture of Life in our Church and in society.

In case you did not know, the priests of Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc celebrate Mass at the nursing homes within our parish boundaries. About once every three months, we visit the residents for prayer, Anointing of the Sick, and Confession. In fact, there are dozens of men and women from our parish who are involved in similar ministries. For example, we have parishioners who take Communion to the homebound, and others volunteer as "Super Neighbors" to seniors in our community. These are ways we put our Catholic faith into action: we serve and honor the dignity of everyone.

40 DAYS FOR LIFE THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 25, TO MONDAY, NOVEMBER 3

Motivated by faith, individuals are gathering peacefully outside abortion facilities throughout the country to pray for the women who enter, the workers who provide abortion services, and the innocent lives lost within. The 40 Days for Life campaign takes place twice a year as a witness to the Gospel of Life. Our goal is not only to shut down these clinics, but to change hearts and minds. Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc has adopted a day of coverage on Sunday, October 26, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The site is Planned Parenthood at 3255 E. Main Street. A minimum of two volunteers are needed to pray at the clinic for each hour-long shift. Sign up using the QR code here. There is perhaps no more beautiful celebration than when parents bring their newborn child to the waters of baptism. Parents, godparents, family, and friends share in this sacrament with incomparable joy. For in baptism, we share in Christ's death and resurrection, and through the outward signs of water and oil, are made *children of God* and given the hope of eternal life with Him.

"The death and resurrection of Jesus is the heart of our faith and the basis of our hope."¹ Through our Lord Jesus Christ, our sins are forgiven, death is overcome, and life is victorious. "Hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite not knowing what the future may bring."² Because of this Christian hope, we can face the unknown trials of life with faith rather than fear.

We are called to be signs of hope to all people, especially those whose goodness, value, and dignity are undermined. As members of the Body of Christ, we carry this hope with us as we continue Jesus' mission on earth. Pope Leo XIV encourages us, "How important it is that each and every baptized person feel himself or herself called by God to be a sign of hope in the world today."³

Sadly, there is a devastating absence of hope today. We see this most profoundly in a sweeping disregard for human life in its most vulnerable forms and stages. Abortion and assisted suicide are products of

hopelessness and despair. Yet even amid the increasing attacks on human life, we know that the "storms that buffet us will never prevail, for we are firmly anchored in the hope born of grace, which enables us to live in Christ and to overcome sin, fear and death."⁴

We have been entrusted with a message of hope for the woman who finds herself unexpectedly pregnant or for the man diagnosed with a terminal illness. At these challenging moments, we must bring God's presence, witnessing to His love, and inspiring a renewal of hope in those whose hearts are burdened. For "hope is born of love and based on the love springing from the pierced heart of Jesus upon the cross."⁵

Having been "buried with Christ in Baptism, we receive in his resurrection the gift of a new life that breaks down the walls of death."⁶ Confident of God's presence within us, may we share the Gospel of Life with those most in need of hope, knowing that "the grace of God precedes and accompanies his people as they press forward firm in faith, active in charity and steadfast in hope."⁷

EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

WHAT is it and WHY is it worth your time?

Eucharistic Adoration is a form of prayer which includes spending time before the Holy Eucharist (typically one hour or more). It is a response to Jesus' plea in the Garden of Gethsemane, "Could you not spend one hour with me?" In Adoration, one can read, pray silently, and just "be" with Jesus. No agenda. No expectations.

Many of us ask ourselves, "But how can I squeeze an hour of Adoration in every week? Life is crazy right now!" - Jesus is inviting you to include Him in the crazy! Adoration can become like any other appointment on your family's calendar. Once you experience this prayerful time, you will wonder how you got by without it!



ADORER SPOTLIGHT - Tom Kaczowski, Parishioner



Twenty years ago, my neighbor was planning to be out of town and asked if I would fill his Eucharistic Adoration time slot. Even though I was raised Catholic, I admitted that I had never actually been to the Chapel for Adoration and didn't really know what to do. He asked me if I prayed. I replied, "Yes." "Good," was his response, "Now go to Adoration, sit quietly in front of the Blessed Sacrament, and listen to our Lord."

Not really comprehending his directive, I asked what time I would need to go. He responded, "Friday at 3:00 a.m." That completely surprised me—did I really have to be at St. Joan's at three o'clock in the morning? Honestly, I wasn't happy about my decision to help as an Adorer in the middle of the night.

As a former coach there is a simple phrase that I have always held true: "I hear, I forget. I see, I remember. I do, I understand."

Whenever I talk about Eucharistic Adoration, I simply encourage others to get involved themselves, we offer Eucharistic Adoration 24 hours a day — they will quickly understand its value. This once reluctant parishioner has kept that 3:00 a.m. Adoration hour at St. Joan of Arc for the past twenty years. I am blessed as a Catholic that I can be in the true presence of our Lord Jesus Christ and listen.





Parish Mission Trip Testimony: Kennedy Wilke

San Ignacio, Belize | Sacred Heart Parish and School | June 14-20, 2025

On June 14, 2025, I had the incredible privilege of joining Father Schalk and 17 fellow parishioners on St. Peter St. Joan of Arc's very first mission trip to San Ignacio, Belize. **From the moment we arrived, I felt a deep sense of purpose and unity among our group.** We didn't know each other that well going into it, but we knew we were there to serve and spread God's love. I also learned very quickly that we were there to receive – receive the love, faith, and joy of a community that welcomed us with open arms.

Our mission partnered with Sacred Heart Parish, where we focused on two main projects: leading Vacation Bible School (VBS) for local children and helping build a sidewalk at the affiliated junior college.

I had the joy of serving as a group leader during VBS, guiding children from station to station and getting to know each of them along the way. Despite many of these kids facing real hardships at home, they radiated enthusiasm, curiosity, and pure joy. Their energy was contagious, and their faith was both simple and profound. **Witnessing God's light shine so clearly through them was a reminder of how simple and powerful faith can be.**

In addition to VBS, I also helped with the multi-day sidewalk construction project. On one of the days, there weren't enough tools for everyone, so I spent time talking with a local crew member named Manny. He shared stories about his upbringing, his love for Belize, and his dream of becoming a tour guide. His resilience and pride in his country left a deep impression on me. Despite life's challenges, he exuded joy and gratitude, **reminding me that God's presence isn't dependent on our circumstances, but is rooted in His unwavering love for us.**

Before this trip, I was hopeful that I would make a difference for others and leave a positive impact on the San Ignacio community, but **what I did not expect was the deeper personal connection with God.** I so clearly saw God's love in action and have started developing a greater appreciation for God's presence and power in my own life. Simply put, this experience has strengthened my faith and trust in God, especially when faced with unfamiliar circumstances and challenges. *Continued on next page of the report*






