

# SUMMER UPDATE FROM SEMINARIAN MICHAEL RHATICAN

Dear St. Peter St. Joan of Arc family,

Greetings again from Rome! The Lord was very good to me during my summer away from home. Although I certainly would have liked to return to the Columbus diocese for the summer, the North American College asks its seminarians who have finished their first year in Rome to stay abroad the following summer. Because of this, my summer assignment consisted of one month in a parish in west Ireland, one week helping with orientation for the new seminarians, and two weeks in Calcutta, India (a huge thank-you to St. Teresa's Outreach for sponsoring my trip there!) I also had the honor of meeting our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV. It was definitely a full and busy summer, but it was also full of many graces and opportunities to grow closer to God.

I very much enjoyed parish life in Ireland, which mostly consisted of serving at Masses, weddings, baptisms, and funerals. I also accompanied Fr. Shane, the pastor, when we visited families' houses for sick calls, wakes, or simply a cup of tea and some "lovely chat" with parishioners. My desire to become a diocesan priest surely grew during my time in Ireland, thanks be to God.

On the other hand, my time in India was very challenging but also very formative. I was in a new country where Catholicism is mostly persecuted, and I got incredibly sick for a few days with a bacterial infection. However, Jesus helped me stay close to Him in prayer and trust Him in all circumstances. He gave me the grace to generously serve the poor and the dying and taught me to love them in small ways. Although I mostly served Hindu men who spoke no English, I felt I was able to show them the good news of Jesus by unconditionally loving and serving them.

Thank you for your prayers and support during my time in seminary! Know of my prayers for all of you as well! God bless!

## REMEMBERING SAINT PETER SAINT JOAN OF ARC LEGACY PLANNING


### USING A TRANSFER ON DEATH DESIGNATION

This is the third installment of a four-part series on topics for making legacy gifts to the St. Peter St. Joan of Arc Endowment Fund or to St. Peter St. Joan of Arc Church ("SPSJOA" shall mean either the Endowment Fund or the Church). Life insurance will be discussed in the next installment.

Ohio law provides that the owner of a banking, credit union, or brokerage account can provide who will receive the balance or portion of the balance of such an account upon the death of the owner. The process is as easy as requesting the appropriate form from the institution at which the account is established. Generally, the form will have a reference to "transfer upon death" but some institutions may use other words (such as "payable upon death") for its description. The form would be completed to state that all or a portion of the account would be transferred to SPSJOA upon the death of the owner.

For example, Sally Parishioner has a savings account at a local bank having a current balance of \$25,000. Sally obtained a "transfer on death" form from the bank and completed it to provide that "upon my death, 50% of the account would be paid to SPSJOA and the balance would be paid to my son, Jeff." Of course, the account could be more or less than the \$25,000 at the time of the Parishioner's death.




