Motivated by faith, individuals are gathering peacefully outside abortion facilities throughout the country to pray for the women who enter, the workers who provide abortion services, and the innocent lives lost within. The 40 Days for Life campaign takes place twice a year as a witness to the Gospel of Life. Our goal is not only to shut down these clinics, but to change hearts and minds. **Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc has adopted a day of coverage on Sunday, October 26, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** The site is Planned Parenthood at 3255 E. SPOTLIGHT ON VOCATIONS

At the start of each Mass, we pray the Angelus for vocations, lifting up the names of those who have answered the call. Over the next several weeks, we invite you to meet the **faces** of those **called** to vocations from our parish family and reflect on the power of prayer in fostering vocations.



NATHANAEL CAMPION

Hello Parish Family!

My name is Nathanael Campion. I am in my third year of temporary vows with the Servants of Christ Jesus and just finished pre-theology at St. John Vianney Seminary in Denver, Colorado.

My hometown is Columbus, Ohio where I was a parishioner at Our Lady of Peace before going to St. Thomas More Newman Center, when I was a student at Ohio State; however, I would frequently attend Mass with my dad who is a parishioner at St. Peter.

My family consists of Tom (dad) & Kristen Scarpitti and Anne (mom) & Andy Bott. My siblings are Brian & Kenzie (baby niece Jane), Noah, and Tessa.

I had a full summer! I hiked the Camino de Santiago with my dad for a week, preached at two LifeTeen summer camps, learned how to direct the 8-day Spiritual Exercises of St Ignatius, and took a two week course on religious life through the Institute for Religious Life. This fall I begin a 3-year full time apostolate at Mullen High School in Denver, Colorado where I am teaching freshman and sophomore theology.

My favorite prayer is "St. Ignatius Loyola's Suscipe"

**"Take, Lord, Receive,
 All my liberty, my memory, my understanding, my entire will,
 All I have and possess.
 You have given it all to me.
 To you, O Lord, I return it.
 All is yours, do with it what you will.
 Give me only your love and your grace. That's enough for me."**

My favorite saint: Sr. Clare Crockett, not quite a saint yet, but Servant of God, was an Irish sister with the "Servants of the Home of the Mother" who died in an earthquake as a missionary in Ecuador. She has been an example of refusing Jesus nothing and responding to the totality demanded by the Gospel in the modern world, especially as a member of a new missionary religious community. I highly recommend the documentary about her: "All or Nothing."

SPSJOA can pray for our community's continual self-emptying to Jesus in poverty, chastity, and obedience. We could use some help finishing a capital campaign to add more rooms to our new formation house! God is supplying vocations, and we need help supplying rooms they can live in.



Building Our Future is our parish's capital campaign to expand Catholic education, build up parish life, and enhance spaces for worship, ministry, and community engagement. We are strengthening Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc with the necessary facilities for continued growth.

The *Building Our Future* campaign will have both immediate and lasting impact. In the short term, the campaign will address educational needs by 1.) launching a Pre-K to Grade 2 school at Saint Peter and 2.) constructing a Grade 3 to Grade 8 school at Saint Joan of Arc. This project will immediately expand access to Catholic education during the day. It will also provide space for Family Catechesis and other parish ministries in the evening and on weekends. Long term, this campaign positions the parish to thrive for generations to come. We are investing in our young people, while also making parish life more attractive to current and future parishioners. In short, *Building Our Future* is an effort to solidly our legacy of faith.





Explanation of Financial Categories

INCOME

- **Offertory** - Includes all receipts for standard offertory, including online giving, envelopes and loose cash receipts.
- **Bequests** - Includes special gifts, memorials, bequests and donations from any source including parish societies.
- **Parish Activities** - Includes gross revenue from festivals, socials, raffles, bulletin advertising and all other general fund raisers.
- **Parish Capital Campaign** - Includes contributions to a capital campaign addressing the facility needs of the parish and the future school.
- **Other Parish Income** - Includes receipts of interest, dividends and other types of income not covered in other accounts.
- **Faith Formation** - Includes program fees, contributions, support from participating parishes, tuition and other income specifically applicable to religious education.
- **Diocesan Support Received** - Includes the refund received from the overpayment for The Appeal.
- **Insurance Recoveries** - Includes reimbursement for expenses incurred by St. Joan of Arc Kitchen fire from the insurance company.

EXPENSES

- **Parish Admin & Operations** - Includes all salaries, Rectory expenses, office supplies, Church supplies (liturgy and music), employee benefits, utilities, maintenance repairs and insurance.
- **Missionary Discipleship** - Includes the Bereavement, Respect Life, Walk for Life, English Language Learners (ELL), Anthony's Garden, Golden Classics, Quilters and Surviving Divorce Ministries.
- **Charities** - Includes all parish charitable and civic projects, either for individuals or for organized groups. St. Teresa's Outreach Income and Expense is not presented.
- **Diocesan Assessment** - Includes a 10% assessment on most income from the parish, used to support diocesan programs and services.
- **Taxes** - Includes real estate taxes paid on all or part of an owned property which does not qualify for total tax exemption.
- **Faith Formation** - Includes all costs specifically applicable to religious education, such as supplies, stipends, subsidies, books, curriculum materials, seminars and speakers.
- **Parish Capital Campaign** - All costs specifically applicable to the capital campaign, such as fundraising consultants and architecture fees.
- **Depreciation** - Includes recognition over time the cost of major capital projects, including repair and renovations.




