FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We have been blessed with very challenging Gospel readings over the past few weeks. This weekend is no exception. Jesus talks about the cost of discipleship, rejecting the idea of following Him “halfway.” His disciples – that is, you and I – are called to give Jesus our whole selves and nothing less.

In my experience as a priest, I have seen individuals slowly and gradually deepen their commitment to the Lord. In other words, to go “all in” with Christ is a journey. After we are convinced of Christ’s love for us and the purpose that He brings to our life, we make the choice to walk with Jesus, step by step. The process of giving ourselves to Christ completely is meant to take a lifetime.

Jesus takes us by the hand in this process. Oftentimes, the life of the parish is where individuals discover the value of giving (a little bit more of) their lives to God. Current examples would include programs like *Walking with Purpose* and *The Rescue Project*. There are also ministries like *Saint Teresa’s Outreach* and *The Ark*. Groups exist in our parish such as the *Knights of Columbus* and *Young at Heart*. These are experiences in the church that allow Christ to break down the obstacles that prevent us from following Him more closely.

Over the next few months, between now and the holidays – this is a perfect time to settle into a rhythm that includes increased prayer, community, or service. Please consider a little commitment you can make to the Lord in this season. Take the risk of being engaged in our parish family, even more than just Mass on Sunday. Take the next step in your walk with Christ.

**WE WILL OPEN UP OUR
MASS INTENTION BOOK FOR 2026
ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 8.**

What does it mean to have a Mass "offered" for someone? A priest offers every Mass for a particular intention. The most common intention is for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. A parishioner may ask a priest to offer a Mass for his or her deceased loved ones or for other special intentions.

Parishioners can stop by the office at Saint Joan of Arc to schedule intentions for Masses (regardless if the Mass will be celebrated at Saint Peter or Saint Joan of Arc). A Mass Intention will only be scheduled when the person presents the priest's stipend amount of \$10.00. The stipend amount is fixed and should be no more, no less than \$10.00.

- An individual or family may schedule:
- A maximum of 10 Masses in one calendar year.
- A limit of 2 weekend Masses (as part of the 10 limit).
- An intention for the same person 4 weeks apart if weekday Mass or 4 months apart if a weekend Mass.

Thank you for your patience as we schedule Mass intentions for 2026. May the Lord continue to pour out His blessings upon our parish family through the celebration of the liturgy.






