

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

One of the central themes of this weekend's Gospel is gratitude. The Bible emphasizes repeatedly this essential habit in the spiritual life: giving thanks to God. The words "thank you" are the first words on our lips when we rise in the morning and the last words we speak to God at the end of the day. I encourage people to make listening to God's voice fifty percent of their prayer; expressing gratitude to God could be the other fifty percent. When we continually give thanks to God, we learn how to receive in our hearts His gift of joy.

Speaking of prayer, I failed to mention last weekend that, in addition to being Respect Life Month, October is also dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary. Like every loving mother, the Blessed Virgin Mary enjoys hearing from her children, and the Rosary is a privileged instrument by which we develop a relationship with the Mother of God. In her wisdom, the Church invites us to make time for the Rosary, especially during October. We can use this

beautiful prayer to ponder the central mysteries of our Catholic faith and to give thanks to God for Mary's love.

Let me end by reminding everyone that our parish's annual Impact Report is available online. My favorite part of this report is the testimonies of parishioners who are deepening their love of God at Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc. Of course, an Impact Report cannot capture everything that is happening in a large parish such as ours. However, it is a wonderful resource that helps us consider what God is doing in our community. When I look through the Impact Report, my gratitude for this parish family grows.





At the start of each Mass, we pray the Angelus for vocations, lifting up the names of those who have answered the call. Over the next several weeks, we invite you to meet the **faces** of those **called** to vocations from our parish family and reflect on the power of prayer in fostering vocations.



### NATHAN FRANKART

Hello Parish Family!

My name is Nathan Frankart and I am currently in my final year of theology as a transitional deacon in the Diocese of Cleveland. While taking classes this fall, I am also assigned to St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Parish in Wooster. I will continue my studies at St. Mary Seminary in Cleveland Ohio, just 2 miles away from Lake Erie!

My home town is the "Sandstone Capital of the World," Amherst! It's a decently sized town right on the outskirts of the greater Cleveland metropolitan area. Amherst has St. Joseph Church, which my family and I have been attending for over 20 years.

I have two amazing parents in my mother Kim and my father Steve. I have equally incredible brothers and sisters. Emma, Abby, Ellen, Anna, and Audrey are the best sisters I could ask for! David and Jacob are my brothers and my best friends!

My summer was occupied at St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception in Wooster. This is an agricultural community through and through, but at the same time we have many parishioners that are connected to our local hospital system, and our regional university campuses of Ohio State ATI and the College of Wooster north of town. There is no shortage of things to do, including barn and animal blessings and enjoying time with parishioners out on the lake south of town! I'll be traveling back and forth between this parish and St. Mary Seminary in Cleveland.

My favorite prayer: Prayer to Holy Spirit:

**"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created, and you shall renew the face of the earth."**

My favorite saint is probably St. Maximilian Kolbe, for his bravery and perseverance during World War II, but my favorite (almost) saint is an American priest named Fr. Emil Kapaun. He is currently on the way to sainthood for his holiness and hope that he gave to American POWs while they were all captured during the Korean War. Both of these men demonstrated supernatural courage and virtue in spite of their difficult circumstances, and that gives me strength to boldly live my faith as well.

SPSJOA please pray for patience with myself and those who rely on me in ministry as I try to overcome the challenges of being faithful to both the program of priestly formation but also to the people who I am developing relationships with down in Wooster.

Fun Fact: Every time I go on vacation, I try to find a different diner to have breakfast in! It started on a family vacation to Virginia at the ThunderBird Cafe in McGaheysville, and I'm now always on the hunt for a good place to eat breakfast!

## What is Conjugal Love?

Conjugal love is the love that exists between a husband and a wife. The word “conjugal” comes from the Latin words con (together) and jugum (yoke): “to yoke together.” Only a husband and wife can experience conjugal love, because only a husband and wife have given themselves to one another completely. Many couples nowadays are hesitant to get married. Even though they love each other, they are afraid of a life-long commitment. They want to keep their options open and be free to walk away. Yet, unless they make the decision to get married, they will never experience conjugal love. For it is only when we give ourselves completely to another that we will experience the joy of love for which God has created us.
