FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In this weekend's Gospel, we hear the famous parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector. The Church has adopted an important liturgical gesture from this story. During the *Confiteor* at the beginning of Mass, we follow the example of the tax collector by striking our breast. It is a gift from God to experience sorrow for our sins. We open ourselves to that gift and pray with the humility of the tax collector: "O God, be merciful to me a sinner."

Let me ask the mercy of our parish's Venezuelan population. We have a great number of Venezuelans at Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc, and I was remiss not to mention the canonization of their first two saints. Last Sunday, Pope Leo XIV declared seven new saints, including Saint José Gregorio Hernández Cisneros and Saint Maria Carmen Rendiles Martínez, both of whom are from Venezuela. We give thanks to God for these heavenly intercesores and wonderful models of holiness.

We will honor the entire heavenly court next weekend with a special liturgy. The Solemnity of All Saints is November 1, a day set apart to remember the Church Triumphant. The citizens of heaven pray for us constantly before the throne of God, and we do well to befriend them. Though the Solemnity of All Saints is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year, you are still invited to join us on Saturday for the celebration of Mass at 8:30 a.m. at Saint Joan of Arc.




