





Ministry highlight:

Fall Food Drive Update:

Thank you for your incredible generosity in serving our neighbors in need during our Fall Food Drive in September! We are deeply grateful for your commitment to feeding the hungry.

- 399 food boxes were collected between our two campuses. Of those, 117 boxes were sent to Home for Families, 111 boxes plus numerous paper products were sent to People in Need of Delaware Co., 75 boxes were sent to Help My Neighbor, 60 boxes were sent to St. John Food Pantry and 25 boxes were sent to JOIN. Our food pantry at SPSJOA collected an additional 10 boxes after the drive was complete.
- This comes out to approximately 30,000 pounds, or 15 tons of food collected!
- Additionally, our parishioners donated \$4,353 to Home for Families.






