FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

As I write these words, I reflect upon the recent tragedies that took place in Providence, Rhode Island, and Sydney, Australia. It is heartbreaking to consider the senseless violence suffered by the students at Brown University and by our Jewish brothers and sisters at Bondi Beach. We have long since grown accustomed to seeing this sort of inhumanity in the news. It is a constant reminder of our need for a Savior.

God became man in the person of Jesus to redeem the human race and to teach us what it means to be human. Our Lord demonstrated unyielding clemency and compassion throughout His life on earth, even as He Himself endured senseless violence ("Forgive them, Father, for they know not what they do"). We truly find ourselves when we, like Christ, lay down our lives in love for our neighbor and extend God's mercy. That is what it means to live our humanity to the fullest.

This Christmas, we allow once again the light of our Savior's birth to scatter the darkness that at times threatens to overtake us. We give thanks that Jesus has come to carry with us the burden of sadness and to heal our humanity. He has planted in our hearts the invaluable gift of faith, which orients us toward forgiveness and generous love. There is hope in knowing the Child who takes away the sins of the world.

NEW PROCEDURE FOR OPENING HYMN AND ENTRANCE CHANT

The Entrance Chant, taken directly from Scripture, marks the beginning of the Mass. The words of the chant typically correspond to the liturgical year or another theme from the liturgy.

Recently, Dr. Richard Fitzgerald, the Director of Sacred Music for the Diocese of Columbus, requested parishes sing the Entrance Chant *after* the Opening Hymn. Father Schalk and Crystal Bensonhaver, our own Director of Sacred Music, are working to make this change happen. Beginning in January, we will first sing the Opening Hymn and then the Entrance Chant at Mass. As with any change, it will take time for everyone to get used to this adjustment. We thank you for your patience!






25 boxes of food, household, personal hygiene and cleaning supplies from Saint Joan of Arc Campus were sent to J.O.I.N. in November.


