





We are happy to announce that the renovations of the McEwan Center at the Saint Peter campus will begin after the New Year. This is possible because of generous donors who have committed to our parish's current capital campaign. This immense project, "*Building Our Future*," is moving forward!

Built in 1980, the McEwan Center was designed with a number of classrooms and restroom fixtures. Those classrooms will be transformed, and the restrooms will be replaced (with even more being installed). Other improvements include: HVAC upgrades, a new fire suppression system, and a playground.

When this renovation is complete, we will be ready for Preschool and Kindergarten at Ave Maria Academy, the Catholic school opening at Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc in the fall of 2026. (Registration for new students begins on Monday, January 12!) Ave Maria Academy will grow one grade at a time at the McEwan Center until it houses students in Preschool through second grade. After that, third grade through eighth grade students will enjoy the new building planned for the Saint Joan of Arc campus.

This important capital improvement is not just for the purpose of offering Catholic education at our parish. The young people in our Family Catechesis program will also benefit, as well as other parish ministries. In essence, "*Building Our Future*" is about responding to the needs of our growing parish.

Please pray for a safe and efficient completion of the renovation at the McEwan Center. And please "pardon our dust" at the Saint Peter campus for the next seven months. For the first few months, workers will focus on the lower level, then they will move to the upper level (that is, the main floor). The church and the office side of the McEwan Center will not be affected.

Again, "*Building Our Future*" is underway because of how generously our parishioners have responded to our current capital campaign. We will continue to approach individuals and families, asking them to participate in this effort. If you have yet not heard from Father Schalk or the Capital Campaign Committee, they will reach out to you soon! Thank you in advance for supporting Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc!



### NEW PROCEDURE FOR OPENING HYMN AND ENTRANCE CHANT

There will be a slight change in the way that we begin Holy Mass at St. Peter St. Joan of Arc. In the past, our celebrations began with the Entrance Antiphon (sung by the cantor or choir) and continued with the opening hymn (sung by all). Beginning next month, we will sing the opening hymn and then proceed to the Entrance Antiphon.

There is a rationale behind the change: the Entrance Antiphon is technically one of the prayers of the Mass itself. It comes from Sacred Scripture and beautifully reveals the nature of the liturgical day or season being celebrated. It is meant to be sung right when the priest enters the sanctuary. In fact, the Entrance Antiphon is sometimes called the "Introit," which literally means, "he enters."

The General Instruction of the Roman Missal explains that the "purpose [of the Entrance Antiphon] is to open the celebration, foster unity of those who have been gathered, introduce their thoughts to the mystery of the liturgical time or festivity, and accompany the procession of the priest and ministers."

Thank you all for your patience as we adjust to this change. We are doing our best to celebrate our liturgies with reverence, joy, enthusiasm, and love. Your active participation in the Mass is much appreciated!
