

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

John the Baptist speaks boldly to us in this weekend's Gospel: "Jesus will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire!" Those words capture my desire for our parish! There is nothing I want more than for our community to be on fire with the love of God. To live with this "Divine Fire Within" is to live with passion and joy.

The Blessed Virgin Mary was filled with the fire of the Holy Spirit throughout her life on earth, even from the moment of her conception. Catholics celebrate her Immaculate Conception this Monday, December 8. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, so check the Mass schedule and make plans to honor the Mother of God. 





Adorer Spotlight *Justina*

My name is Justina Rubio, and I've been asked to share how my love for the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament was born and grew within me. Since I was a little girl, my mother taught me to love Jesus in the Eucharist. I remember going with her to adoration, daily Mass, and the daily rosary. God was always part of my life. I grew up in a small, peaceful town where faith and traditions were the meaning of every day. We didn't have television or the internet; our pastimes were work, family, and above all, God. As the years went by, marriage, children, and responsibilities drew me a little away from adoration, although I always tried to go at least once a week.

Then, when my marriage failed, my refuge once again became God. I had to emigrate to the United States with my children. In this country, I fell more deeply in love with the only One who has always loved me and has never left me alone: Jesus. When I arrived here, I heard that churches only opened during Mass, and out of ignorance, I stopped visiting Him for a while. But once I began to form a community, I discovered that there was also adoration of the Blessed Sacrament here and I found Him again.

I don't drive, so many times I depended on my children to get to the chapel. Sometimes I stayed there for long hours waiting for them to pick me up, even without eating or sleeping, but I was happy because I was with the best company. After some time, I made friends in the church who also helped me attend more often, since they would offer me rides. Eventually, God placed in my children's hearts the idea of helping me get my own apartment, and I only asked that it be near the church. And that's exactly what happened. Today, I visit Him whenever I can. In the cold, heat, or rain.

I don't have great things to offer Him, only my prayers. I ask Him to purify them and receive them. I go to be with Him, to talk to Him about my problems, to thank Him for everything and above all, to love Him for all those who don't. I know I ask for more than what I thank Him for, but He knows that my greatest desire is to one day rejoice in the Kingdom of Heaven. I beg Him to forgive me and ask for the salvation of my soul and the salvation of my family.

**In the Eucharist, I discovered that Jesus did not remain in the past.
He lives, He waits, and He loves every day from the altar.**






