

The Complementarity of the Vocations

In God's divine plan, the vocations of marriage and virginity (or "celibacy") complement each other quite beautifully. Married couples benefit from the witness of priests and virgins even as priests and virgins benefit from the witness of married love. When a husband and wife see a priest or a religious sister, they are reminded of the fact that they are made for God, and that no human person—not even their spouse—can ultimately satisfy the longings of their hearts. This helps them to love each other with mercy and compassion, knowing that marriage—for all of its beauty—was never meant to bring perfect happiness in this life. Conversely, when priests and religious sisters see married couples, they are reminded of the spousal relationship that they are meant to have with God. The love between husbands and wives becomes a living reflection of the love that the Divine Bridegroom has for them. We are so blessed to have a parish where priests, religious sisters, and married couples all help each other to love as we journey together towards heaven!






MAKING A LEGACY GIFT TO ST. PETER ST. JOAN OF ARC USING LIFE INSURANCE

This is the fourth installment for making legacy gifts to St. Peter St. Joan of Arc or to an Endowment of the parish. Previous bulletin articles have reviewed legacy giving using your 1) Last Will and Testament, 2) transfer on death designations for bank and investment accounts, and 3) retirement accounts (IRA, 401K etc.).

Life insurance is often purchased to provide for a specific potential future need. Common examples of such needs are (1) to supplement the income of the family in case of the death of a bread winner, and (2) to provide cash at death to pay expenses allowing the preservation of the estate for heirs, and (3) avoiding the sale of assets that the heirs would prefer to leave intact to continue producing income and to provide a legacy for the deceased loved one.




Often, the reason for the original purchase of the life insurance becomes less important over time. As time passes and dependents become economically self-sufficient and annual costs of supporting the household are reduced, the need to supplement the family income in the event of the death of a bread winner becomes less critical. As the estate tax landscape changes (think repeal of the Ohio death tax and increase of the federal estate tax exempt), the reliance on life insurance to pay estate taxes and safeguard the family farm or business may lessen.

Life insurance can play an important and legitimate role in legacy gift planning. Donors can gift life insurance they purchased on their lives to SPSJOA, often with the donor agreeing to pay the periodic premiums. Alternatively, a donor may simply name SPSJOA as the beneficiary under a life insurance policy or assign policy benefits to SPSJOA, such as policy dividends.






