This weekend, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Epiphany. We hear the familiar story of the Magi who come from the East in search of the newborn King. These Wise Men represent every human heart that longs to see the beauty of God. Christians imitate the Magi by stirring up our desire for Jesus through prayer and seeking His face in our daily life.

Along these same lines, our parish will begin "The Search" in less than two weeks. Provoking thought and inspiring faith, this unique series shines a light on the restlessness of our heart. All of us have questions about life that our secular culture fails to answer, because only when we turn to God does the meaning of life come into focus. Join us for the initial session of "The Search" on Wednesday, January 14, and feel free to bring a friend.

Lastly, let me draw your attention to Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, whose feast day is January 4. Mother Seton was the first native-born citizen of the United States to be canonized. She is also considered the founder of Catholic education in this country. We ask for her intercession as we open our Catholic school, Ave Maria Academy, in the fall. Moreover, we ask her to pray for our nation as we celebrate our 250th anniversary later this year. Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, pray for us!





**SUNDAY, JANUARY 4, WE CELEBRATE THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD,
ONE OF THE OLDEST CHRISTIAN FEASTS**

It commemorates the visit of the Magi to the Child Jesus. Marking our doors or porch steps with blessed chalk is a centuries-old Epiphany tradition and a fun, visible way to dedicate our homes and the New Year to God.

This year's inscription is:

20 + C + M + B + 26

- “20” and “26” represent the new year (2026).
- The “+” signs represent the Cross.
- **CMB** are the initials of the traditional names of the Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase “*Christus mansionem benedicat*” – “May Christ bless this house.”

Blessed chalk will be available after all Masses this weekend for you to take home.




