FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I encourage you to do some sort of fasting this Lent, because that sacrifice will create space in your life for something spiritually worthwhile.

Tips for making a good confession

Before: Ask God for the grace to see your shortcomings and to trust in his mercy. Review a good examination of conscience that helps to identify your sins. Make a list of your sins to use during confession.

During: Be direct. It is typically not necessary to give the context for your sins. Mention your sins and not the sins of others. Know that the priest is there to help you and that God is there to forgive you.

After: Thank God for the gift of reconciliation. Do the penance assigned to you with gratitude for Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. Commit to sharing the mercy you received by offering forgiveness and being an instrument of peace.

Sweaters for Seniors Collection

Thanks to the immense generosity of our parish, STO donated 46 large bags of sweaters, socks and mittens to LifeCare Alliance in January! These sweaters will be distributed to clients in the Help at Home service, seniors in the Meals on Wheels program and those in need from the Cancer Support group. In addition, 10 large bags of items not suited to the senior collection were donated to our HOST Street Ministry. Thank you also to the volunteers who helped gather, sort, bag and deliver these donations from our two campuses. We could not do it without you! LifeCare Alliance expressed much appreciation for this collection, and they look forward to our continued support next year.

This included 2,324 children, 1,515 seniors and 390 new families. 22 boxes of food, household, personal hygiene and cleaning supplies from Saint Joan of Arc Campus were sent to J.O.I.N. in January. 22 crates of food from Saint Joan of Arc Campus were sent to Help My Neighbor food pantry in January.




