FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

To all of our married couples, let me wish you a very happy World Day of Prayer for Marriage! The Church in the United States takes this weekend (right before Valentine's Day) to promote the goodness of married life. We give thanks to God for all the married couples who, through their commitment to each other, strengthen society and the Church. May God inspire more and more young people to say Yes to this beautiful vocation.

Two weeks ago, very few people were able to attend Mass on Sunday because of the terrible snowstorm. Seeing our churches empty that day was a bit surreal, and it made me all the more grateful for the crowds we typically have. What Should I do if my Spouse is not Catholic?

When faithful Catholics marry non-Catholics, their marriages can become complex. These people often wonder how they can be faithful and loving to Jesus and their spouse at the same time. If you fall into this category, here is a basic gameplan:

1. Resolve to love Jesus with all of your heart until the day that you die, regardless of whether or not your spouse converts to Catholicism.
2. Resolve to love your spouse with all of your heart until the day that you die, regardless of whether or not he/she converts to Catholicism.
3. Pray for your spouse every single day.
4. Periodically invite (don't force!) your spouse to accompany you to Mass, prayer, Adoration, a Galilee group, etc., respecting his/her freedom to say "no."
5. Be patient.
6. Trust that God has a plan, that He has called you and your spouse together, and that He desires your spouse's conversion even more than you do.
