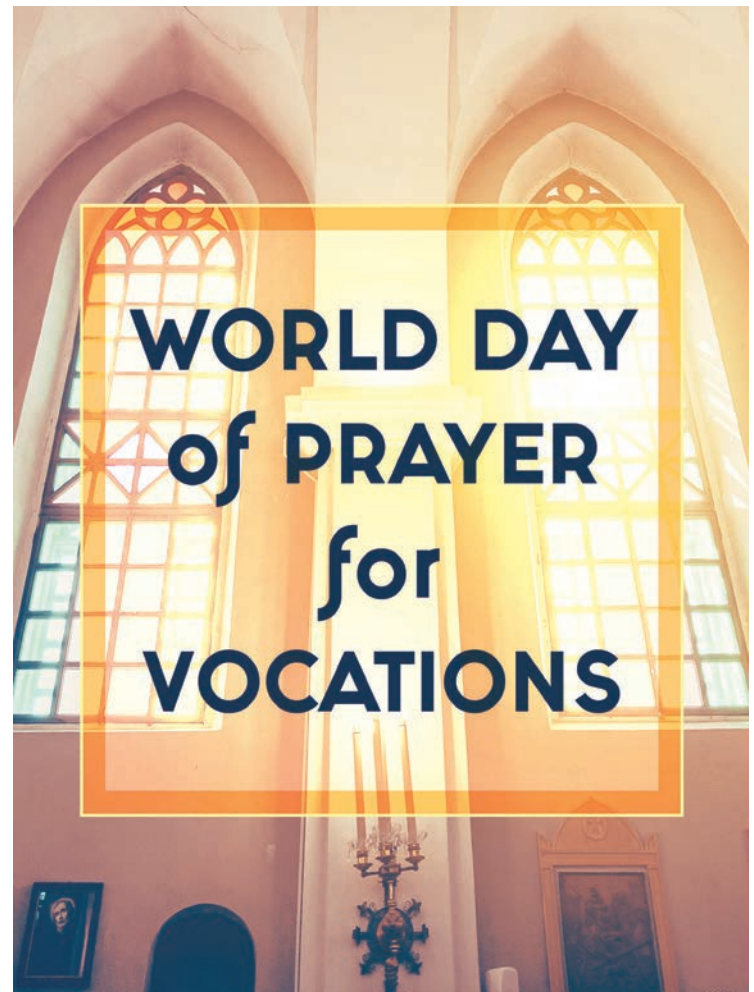

Good Shepherd Sunday & World Day of Prayer for Vocations

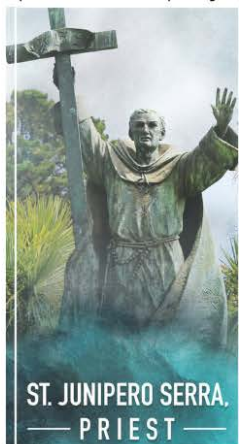
