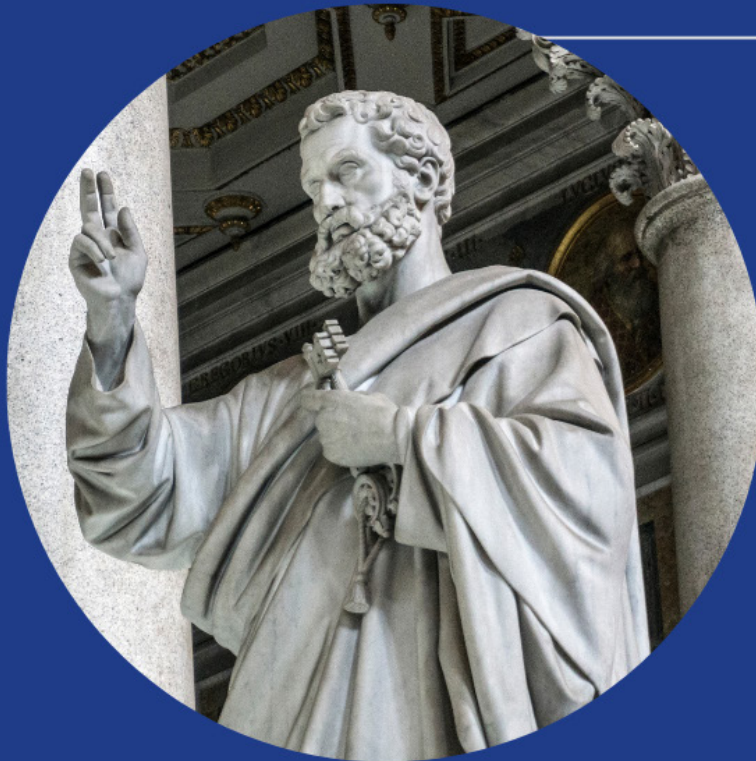

ST. PETER ST. JOAN OF ARC: A HISTORY HISPANIC OUTREACH

For over 20 years, our parish has provided a welcome space for immigrants. In 2005, parishioners at St. Joan of Arc started a Literacy Program to help non-English speaking families. Volunteers took training at the Columbus Literacy Council and Fr. Jeff Rimelspach welcomed the first students from Mexico. This ministry has grown over the years to teach English to natives of many countries from around the world.



At St. Peter, Fr. Justin Reis noticed a number of members from the Hispanic community were attending Mass. In 2008, a committee was formed to determine ways to support the local Hispanic population.

The Missionary Sisters, Servants of the Word, were instrumental in the success of an outreach mission. For three weeks and many late nights, the sisters would go knocking on doors in the neighborhoods inviting families to Saint Peter.



On March 21, 2009, Mass in Spanish began every third Saturday with a bilingual Mass on the first Sunday which was added in November.

Additionally, classes through the Dominican Learning Center were started to provide English as a Second Language and Bible studies were held in Spanish.



These outreach efforts at both campuses have enabled many people from around the world to find a welcoming place to practice the Catholic faith.

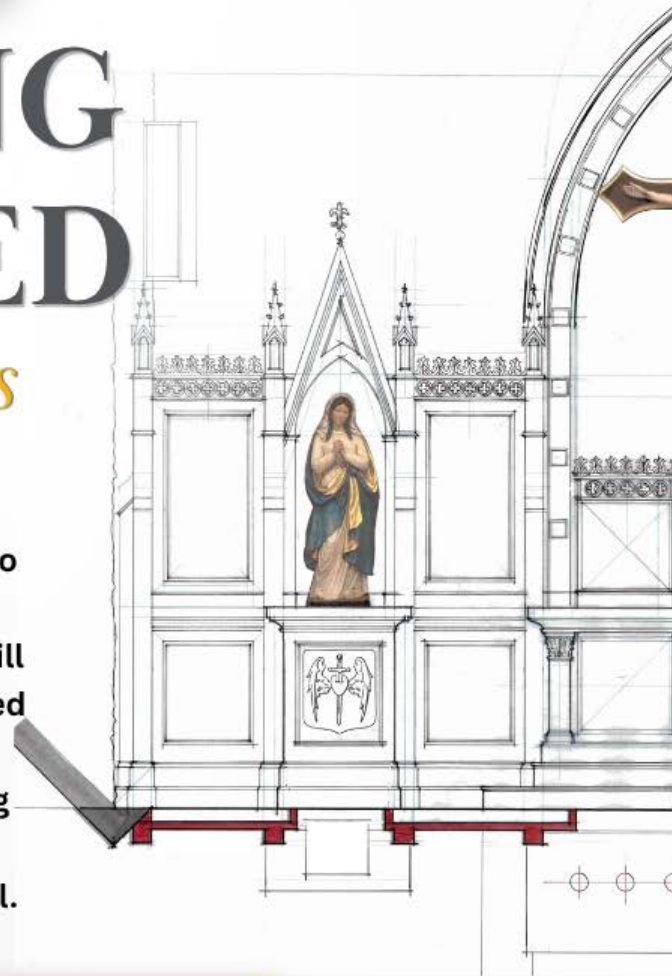

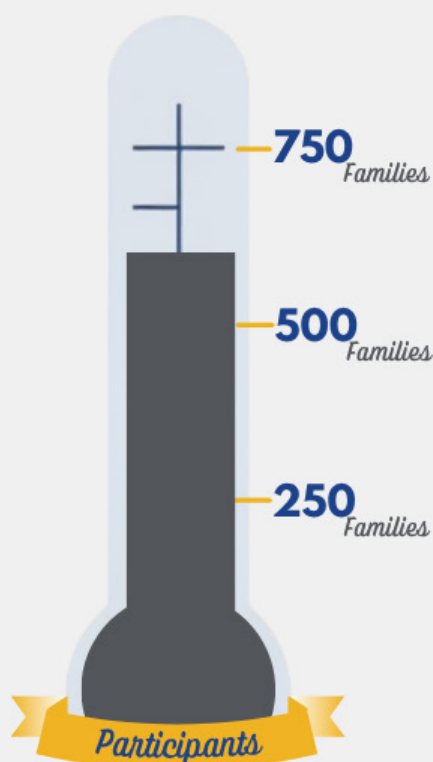

TESTIMONIES FROM PARISHIONERS BEGIN THIS WEEK



While in Belize last month, parishioners from Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc worked to make improvements to one of the Sacred Heart school buildings in San Ignacio. We trimmed branches away from roof lines, replaced damaged soffit and fascia wood, and gave the building a much-needed fresh coat of paint. The building we worked on houses classrooms for intermediate students (approximately 2nd-3rd grade). We systematically replaced rotted wood with new materials purchased from a local hardware store. The new paint—a calm yellow accented with deep red for the doors and trim—stays consistent with the rest of the school. On our last day, a few students even helped us paint during their break. They were incredibly proud to contribute and remarkably managed to keep their uniforms spotless!

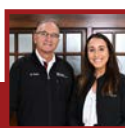


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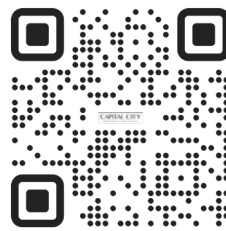
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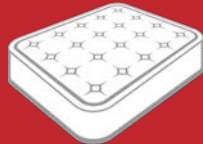
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
