BELIZE INTERNATIONAL MISSION TRIP



” CALLED TO SERVE, BLESSED TO RECEIVE



It was a steep climb to Esther's home. The path was uneven, mostly dirt with some scattered rocks and dead palm fronds. As I paid close attention to my footing, I wondered if she and her family climb this hill each day as they return home from work or school. One of my teammates asked her, Yes, they do. Six of us from the mission team brought Esther a "blessing bag" filled with staples including rice, flour, and brown sugar, among other items. She was very grateful for our visit and the gifts, and her smile expanded when we asked if we could pray with her. It was a powerful experience to stand in front of Esther's small concrete block home and pray with her for the well-being of her family. My imagination of a moment such as this fueled my commitment to participate with last month's Belize mission trip. It has proven to be one of my greatest blessings!

The 23-member team began preparations for the mission trip in January. We settled on guiding words of faith, love, and service for our trip. Father Schalk led the monthly meetings, stressing the importance of our growing in humility and trust. We discussed Scripture, the Litany of Trust prayer, an encyclical from Saint John Paul II, and a speech from Saint Teresa of Calcutta. The discussions challenged us to identify opportunities for our spiritual growth. We also began to pray daily for one another. Andrea and her brother Jason wrote two team prayers – one that we prayed prior to departure and another that we prayed while serving. We continued to build on this foundation once the trip began by celebrating daily mass, praying a daily Rosary on the bus rides into town, and sharing evening reflections about our attentiveness to God's voice and our witness of His goodness. Faith.

Each day, God's love worked through us as we were attentive to one another's needs within the team and within the Sacred Heart Primary School community.

The team grew quickly in unity. We regularly checked in with one another by giving a word of encouragement, covering during breaks, or holding a ladder. Andrea, Emily, and Patrick were the first-aid team, and they were quick to treat cuts and scrapes, wrap an ankle, or proactively offer electrolyte beverages to avoid dehydration.

The love that we showed one another reflected back to us tenfold as we interacted with the children of Sacred Heart. The children were cheerful and eager to be with us – Amelia drew a picture of me on the back of her star craft, and Lexi and Zion insisted on gifting me their stars, so we worked quickly to make stars that they could take home to their families. When teammate Ava asked "little" Ava what she wanted to be when she grew up, "little" Ava replied, "I want to be important just like you." Love.

We serve because we love, and this team loved serving the children and families of Sacred Heart! In the mornings, all of us participated with VBS – some were in the church sharing stories or songs; others performed a skit, led recreation activities, assisted with crafts, or guided groups of children from one activity to the next. In the afternoons, all of us dove into the much-needed repairs and painting of one of the school buildings. The home visits were split up among several days, so smaller groups within the team could deliver blessing bags and pray with families. Our team members spanned five decades, and the Holy Spirit guided each of us as we contributed our unique gifts to the mission and kept Christ in the center. Service.

It is a daily choice to walk with others, to trust Jesus, to have humility, to surrender and detach from our desires and fears, but when we do, there is peace – abundant peace – enough to share with others. We shared peace and God's love with one another, with the students of Sacred Heart, with many families, and with Esther on that Wednesday afternoon. With God's grace, memories of these encounters and experiences will provide strength and hope as each of us climbs the steep path *Home*.

MARRIAGE MINISTRY UPDATES

THE POWER OF FORGIVENESS

God created marriage to be a little reflection of his own love. When a man and woman get married, they are meant to become a living image of Christ's love for the world: "Husbands, love your wives even as Christ loves the Church" (Eph 5:25).

But it's crucial to remember that Christ manifested his love for the world through forgiveness. Because we live in a fallen world, his love had to take the form of forgiveness and mercy. From the Cross, he called out to his heavenly Father, "Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do" (Lk 23:34).

What this means is that, in order for husbands and wives to live up to their own calling, they, too, must constantly forgive one another. Forgiveness is what makes marriage possible and beautiful. It's what allows married couples to become little images of Christ. And it is always the source of renewal in marriage, even when things seem hopeless.

So if you feel stuck in your marriage—if you feel like you're walking through a valley of darkness—consider asking Jesus, "Lord, in what ways are you asking me to forgive my spouse?" And then ask him for the grace to pray that prayer: "Father forgive him (her), for he (she) knows not what he (she) does."

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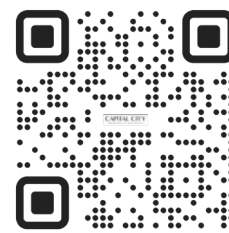
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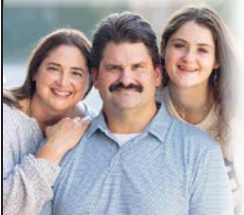
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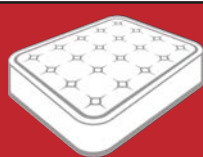
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
