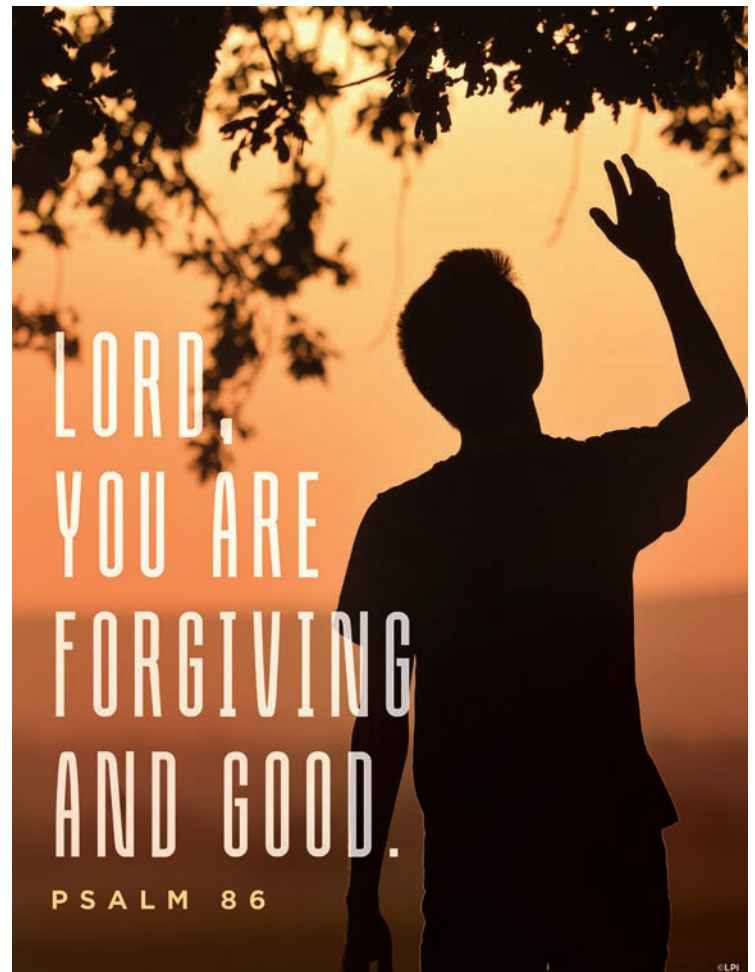

INTERNATIONAL MISSION TRIP

SACRED HEART SCHOOL: VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL CRAFT TIME
THE CHILDREN WHO LED ME TO CHRIST



I was unsure what I may encounter on my second mission trip to Belize. Honestly, I worried it could not possibly be as joy-filled or awe-inspiring as it had been last June. But I have come to realize, Jesus has a way of capturing our hearts over and over again... it is only dependent on our willingness to allow Him.

Months leading into our trip, our mission team planned the VBS theme "The Great Commission" (Matthew 28:16-20): "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations." We paired this with the excitement of NASA's recent Artemis mission, decorating school spaces with planets, stars, and galaxy images. Sharing with the kids, that just as astronauts are launched on a mission of exploration, Jesus sends each of us on mission to bring His love to the world.

Monday, more than 200 children ages 5-8 filled our classroom to create stars inspired by Psalm 147:4: "He counts the stars and calls them all by name." They decorated each star with colorful stickers, sparkling gems, and words that reflected their hearts. I watched little hands carefully write "Strength," "Prayer," and "I love Jesus." Many couldn't wait to tell us who would receive their star. Whether it was their mother, sister, or aunt, they were already thinking about how they could share joy with someone they loved.

One little girl quietly looked up at me and said, "Can I ask you a question?" I said, "Yes of course!" She replied, "Am I doing this for real, or is this a dream?" My heart skipped, I smiled and assured her this was real. She beamed from ear to ear and returned to her craft with even more confidence, like she was confirming "Yes, this is for real!" I will never forget that moment. Something as simple as sitting beside her, creating together, had become something extraordinary in her eyes.

As the week continued, children from other age groups gathered outside our classroom windows, excitedly asking questions about crafting. Some even attempted to climb through the windows and join in! Their excitement was infectious, but what struck me most wasn't their enthusiasm for crafts, it was the joy they carried. These children, many of whom face challenges I will never know, greeted every day with open hearts, infectious smiles, and an eagerness to love the people around them.

As the week continued, we welcomed an additional 400 children! More than 220 children aged 8-12yrs and 175 aged 12-15yrs. The middle group created "Mission Badges" to remind them to "Go Make Disciples," proudly clipping them to backpacks, shoes, belt loops, and water bottles, excited to carry their mission wherever they went. Our oldest students made bracelets reminding them of Jesus' promise: "I am with you always." As they carefully strung each bead, we talked about how Christ walks with us wherever life takes us. Bracelets were made for relatives battling illness in the hospital, friends that had moved into their family home during challenging times, and their "BFF" that could not be at school that day.

Looking back, I realize the crafts were simply the invitation. The real work God was doing wasn't with paper stars, beads, or luggage tags. It was the children who taught me what love really looks like.

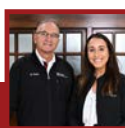

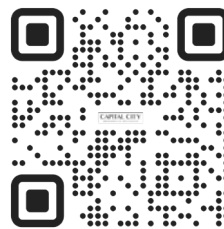

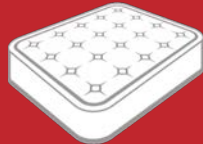
