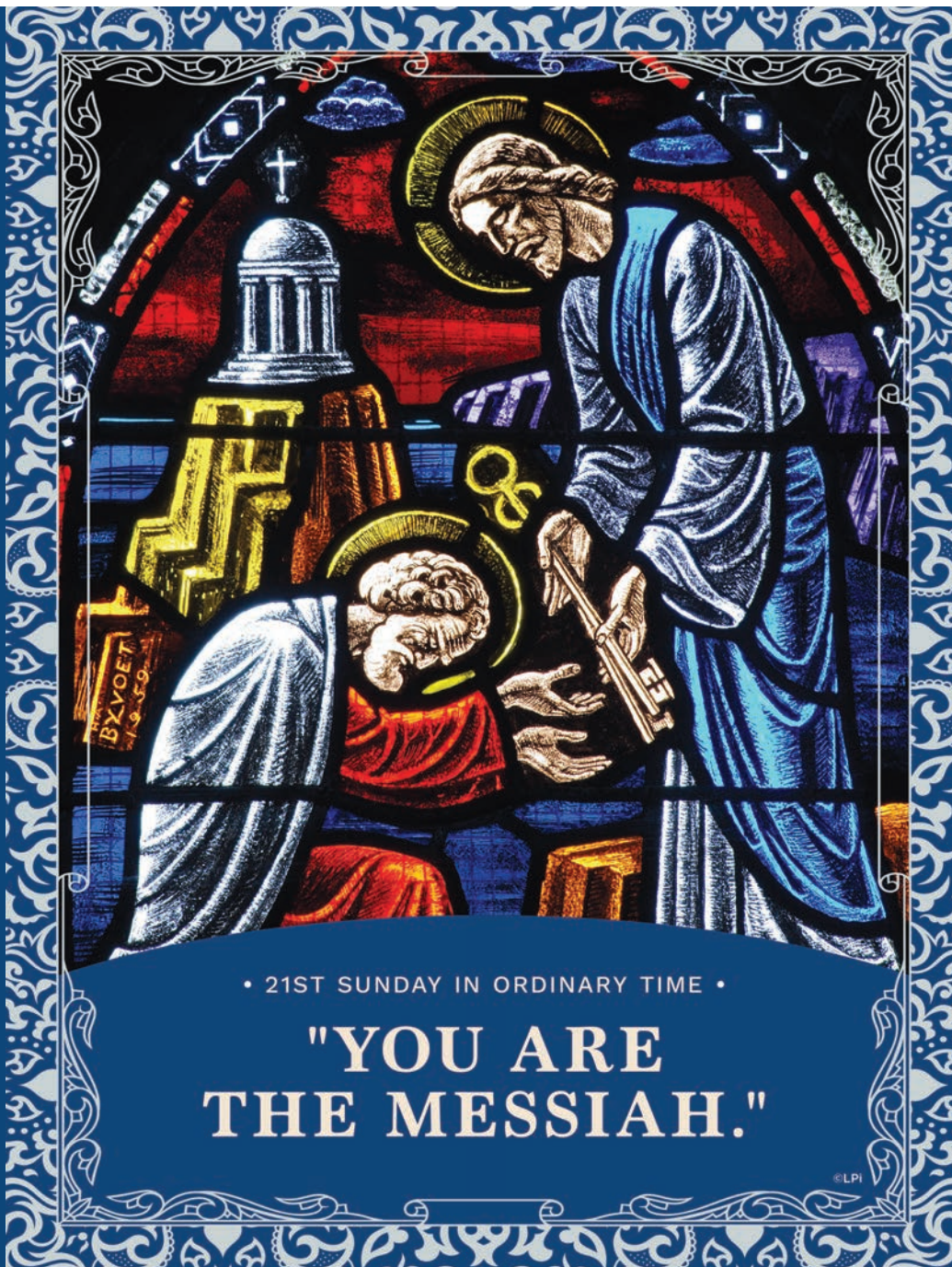

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

In this weekend's liturgy, we listen to the Gospel where Jesus chooses Peter to be the rock foundation for His Church. We often turn to this Gospel to support our belief that Jesus Himself founded the Catholic Church with a structure for teaching and governance. We also believe that God will guide His Church, which is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic, until Jesus comes again.

Essential to the Church's ministry is its care for the afflicted. At Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc, we are constantly looking for ways to attend to the marginalized and provide for those in need. To that end, donations received from next weekend's "last Sunday of the month collection for the poor" will go to individuals suffering due to recent natural disasters. We are giving locally to those affected by flooding in Perry and Muskingum Counties, and our church will donate internationally to those impacted by the June earthquakes in Venezuela.

Please note that next weekend is also our parish's annual Ministry Fair. After each Mass, you are invited to learn about a multitude of ministries, all of which are opportunities to get involved in the life of our community. The Ministry Fair is integral to our Stewardship of Time and Talent Campaign. This time of year, we prayerfully discern how God is calling us to share our gifts at Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc.

Lastly, please continue to pray for all of our young parishioners who have returned to school. We are excited to have our own Catholic school in session: Ave Maria Academy opened its doors last Wednesday. And Bishop Earl Fernandes published a pastoral letter on Catholic education last week. In that letter, he outlines his vision for Catholic schools in the Diocese of Columbus, providing direction for our work at Ave Maria Academy. 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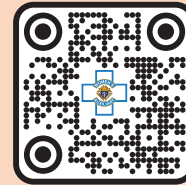

“Why Did I Include Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc in My Estate Planning?”

Honestly, I didn't set out to include the parish in my estate planning. When I first started the process, I wanted to make sure my kids were taken care of. Charity and the parish weren't even on my radar. Following the few examples I knew from friends and family, I planned to just divide everything between the kids. For whatever reason, I paused and asked myself, “Does it all need to go to the kids?” I decided it did not and then wondered how much more work it would be to add charities. Turns out, it's just adding a line or two to the document.

Knowing the charities I support regularly in my monthly budget are prayerfully considered, I decided those made the most sense for my estate too. So, I settled on a total percentage of the estate for charity and split it between St. Peter St. Joan of Arc and one other charity. My estate plan is aligned with how I live my life, and that feels right. While supporting my kids is the priority, this allows me to support causes with a broader impact and hopefully support them with a larger donation than what I can offer monthly.

This is my short testimony which, I hope, encourages everyone to prayerfully consider including our parish and/or another Catholic organization in your estate planning. If you don't know where to start, St. Peter St. Joan of Arc has a Legacy Society to help you with everything related to estate planning! The Legacy Society hosts workshops and seminars each year to walk parishioners through these steps and to answer questions. The Legacy Society also has a brochure titled “Legacy Planning for Parishioners” which is available in the vestibules at both campuses.

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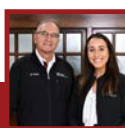


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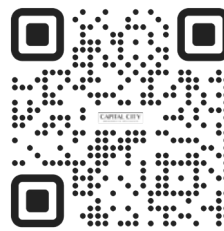
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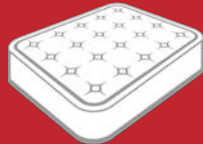
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
