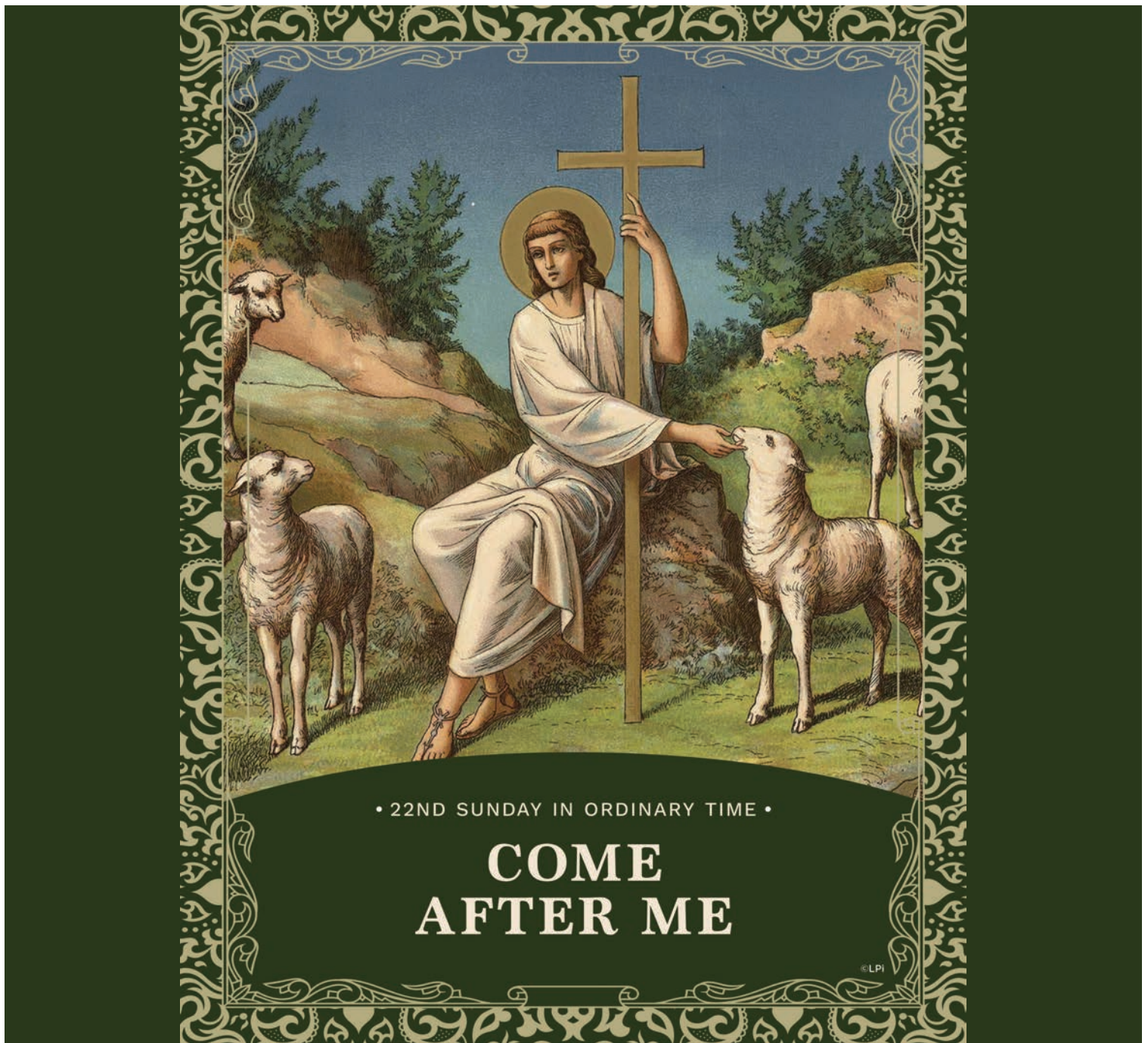

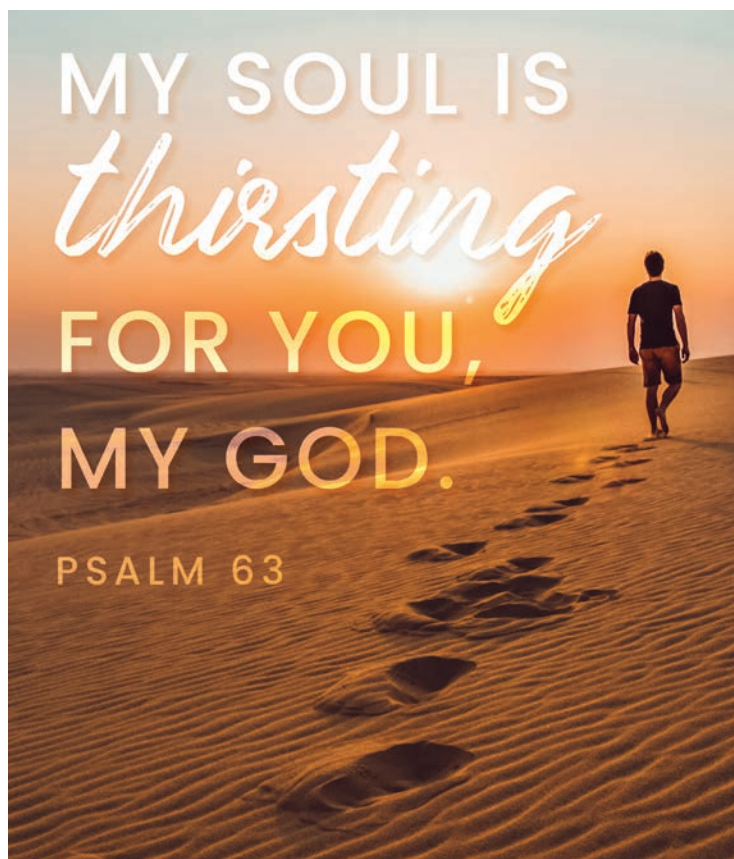

Care for the Poor

\$15,476.92 was donated to STO for the Care for the Poor program in the month of July. These funds allow us to provide financial assistance to our partner organizations each month (Help My Neighbor, J.O.I.N, People in Need and St. Vincent Family Services), as well as our own St. Vincent de Paul and Heart of St. Teresa Street Ministry.

300 bagged lunches

Open Shelter Ministry

300 bag lunches were assembled in July for The Open Shelter.

15 crates

Sandwich Collection

15 crates of sandwiches were collected in July for Holy Family Soup Kitchen.

27 families

St. Vincent de Paul

In July, St. Vincent de Paul provided 27 families with rent, utilities, Kroger gift cards and St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store gift cards.

258 meals

Street Ministry

Heart of St. Teresa (HOST) Street Ministry served hot meals, bagged lunches, and Easter treat bags to about 258 individuals in Columbus in July.

1 full SUV, 16 and 20 crates

Weekly Food Pantry Collection

ALTAR SERVING TRAINING

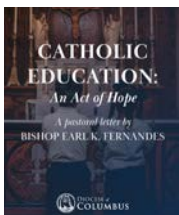
