FROM THE SEMINARIAN'S DESK

This Sunday, the First Reading and Gospel present a particular challenge to us as Christians. We are faced with the difference between intellectually knowing (about) God and personally knowing (trusting) God. Intellectually, knowing God to be all-powerful, Elijah and ourselves might expect God in some big revelation. But most commonly, he reveals himself to us in the deep, quiet recesses of our hearts. Intellectually, Peter knew God could do anything, but he lacked complete faith to walk on water. We might also fall short in our trust in God in many ways: from our work and financial matters to our vocation and family life. Whether we are like Elijah or Peter, two great saints, we are always in need of spiritual growth.

There are many exciting things brewing at our parish: Next weekend will be mission appeal weekend. Having spent a summer in Tanzania, I know how important it is to aid Catholic missions in a rapidly growing environment. As my summer assignment at Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc ends on August 17th, this means the school year is near. For our parish, this year's Back to School is especially special since Ave Maria Academy will open its doors to its first students on August 19th. I have heard much about festival, which is the following weekend (August 20th-22nd). If you see me this weekend, this is my last weekend with you. If you don't, I'll be with you next weekend.

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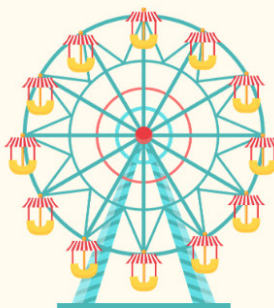
ST. PETER ST. JOAN OF ARC: A HISTORY COMMUNITY FESTIVAL

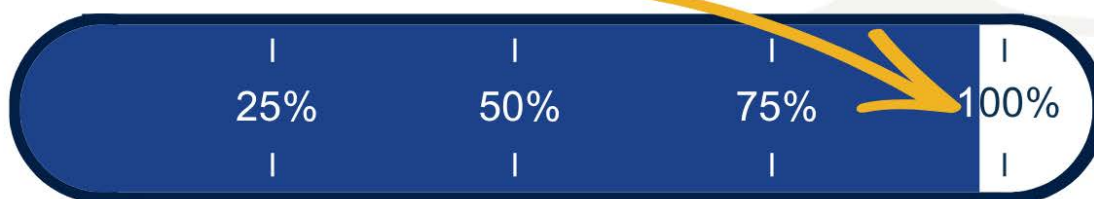

HOMEBOUND MINISTRY



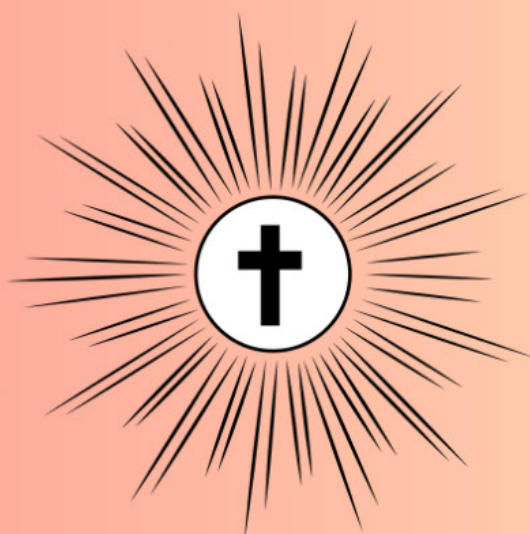
Our parish homebound ministers bring the Holy Eucharist to those in our parish family who are unable to attend Mass due to temporary or permanent conditions.

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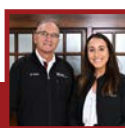

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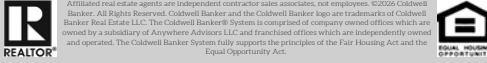
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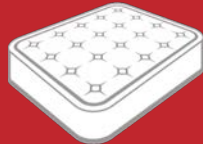
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
