Labor Day weekend gives us the opportunity to thank God for the gift of work. Through his humble labor as a carpenter, Jesus teaches us the dignity of work and its importance to human flourishing. Let us pray for those who are currently without employment, as well as those who are seeking to find a balance between work, family, leisure, and prayer.

We are blessed to welcome to our community Gage Niesen, a seminarian studying to be a priest of the Diocese of Jefferson City, Missouri. His seminary, the Pontifical College Josephinum, has assigned Gage to Saint Peter Saint Joan of Arc as a part of his priestly formation. Gage will be with us for two years, sharing his gifts and participating in the life of our parish.
